DIABETES

Diabetes is one of the leading causes in America for morbidity and mortality. Diabetes is a disease that consists of the inability of the body to produce or utilize insulin. Insulin is a hormone, secreted by the pancreas, in charge of helping the body use sugars and starch as a source on energy. The cause of diabetes is still unknown although there are many factors including hereditary and environment that are strongly associated with it.

When the body does not produce enough insulin then we call it insulin dependent diabetes or type I. This is usually seen in children and young adults and it happens when the body destroys pancreatic beta cells — the only body cells that can produce insulin. The patient with type I diabetes needs several insulin injections during the day.

When there is an inability of the body to utilize insulin then it is called non-Insulin dependent diabetes or type II. It usually begins as insulin resistance and as the body raises the need for insulin then the pancreas decreases the production. Type II diabetes is associated with old age, obesity, family history and ethnicity (Hispanic, Native and African Americans heritage being a significant factor).

The third kind of diabetes is gestational diabetes or diabetes of pregnancy.

It is estimated that 5% to 10% of Americans diagnosed with diabetes have type I and 90% to 95% are diagnosed with type II. About 4 % of all pregnant women have diabetes of pregnancy. There

are 18.2 million Americans with the disease and of those only 13 million have been diagnosed. 1 million new cases are diagnosed every year.

Diabetes complications are related to all body systems. Heart disease is the number one cause of death among diabetics. There is a 2 to 4 times greater chance of heart disease for diabetics; the same is true for strokes. Diabetes is the primary cause of blindness, renal disease, non-traumatic amputations and is strongly associated with high blood pressure, dental disease, neurological disease, and frequent infections, among other complications.

The symptoms of diabetes include increase in thirst, urination, tiredness, hunger and weight loss or gain. Is also important if there is any family history of diabetes. Those factors should warn you to seek screening. ▼

Dr. Rodriguez attended medical school in the Dominican Republic and her Internal Medicine training was in New York at St. Barnabas Hospital, affiliated with Cornell University.
