# Spiritually Speaking

January is almost over. Did you make any resolutions for the New Year? Did you make any decisions about changes you want to make in your life? Making resolutions is easy. Making the actual changes is not. We are creatures of habit, and we don't like to make changes in our lives.

It's not easy to begin an exercise program. Dieting can be more difficult. Making the changes necessary to be more organized or to eat more balanced meals means we have to change several things in our lives.

Maybe you want to go back to school or find a new job or even buy your own house. Perhaps there is a dream you have always had. What keeps you from doing it? Why are we so hesitant to make the final decision or commitment to go for our dream? It's not easy to step out and make major changes and commitments in our lives.

History tells us Jesus had a job. He was a carpenter. He had his career. He had friends. But he knew there was something else he was supposed to do in life. He had the disciples already organized. But he was not ready to take that final step, that final commitment to begin his life's calling.

One day, according to the Gospels, Jesus and his disciples were invited to a wedding that his mother was also invited to. Everything was going fine at the reception until they ran out of wine. The Gospels tell us a story of how Jesus' mother tells him to do something about the wine. Jesus tells his mother that he isn't ready to start his new life. He didn't think it was time yet.

Here he was – thirty years old. He already has his staff hired – the twelve disciples. But he didn't want to make that final deci-

sion to start. His mother refused to listen to him and told the others to just do whatever he said to provide for the wedding guests.

It's like buying a new car. Once you make the decision and sign on the dotted line, you are stuck with the payments. Once you take that first step, there is no going back. Once you start, there is no stopping.

I think this is the real story of the turning water into wine that the Bible gives us. The real story is about Jesus saying he didn't want to start his new life. Mary is tired of waiting for him. To her, it was time for Jesus to get off the couch and out of the house and to start doing what he needed to be doing.

So we too, just sit back and wait. It is scary to make that decision. We wonder if we can really do what we need to do. So, we do nothing. Maybe we are waiting for someone to just drop the answer in our laps. But most of us will never win the lottery.

Maybe we are waiting for someone else to do it for us. Maybe we are just waiting for a "Mary" to come along and tell us to get moving. We are great with excuses. Jesus gave his mother an excuse – "It's not time yet." Mary basically said, "If not now, when? What is keeping you from doing it?"

Once he started, there was no going back. The first step is the most difficult. The end result, however, was the best wine at the wedding. You will never see improvements or changes for the better until you take that first step.

So, what is it you need to be doing? What is it you have been putting off? What is it you are afraid of beginning? What is the



decision you are hesitant to make? What is holding you back? Instead of saying, "It's not time yet," say, "Why not?" Mary was tired of the excuses Jesus gave her. She stopped listening to the excuses and told Jesus to just get it done. What's keeping you from starting the changes you need in life?
